Kiwi Community Assistance**

On behalf of the Hutt City Salvation Army I'd like to pass on our thanks to Tracy and her team at Kiwi Community Assistance. Since the beginning of 2015 we have been regularly picking up significant amounts of mainly frozen food and sometimes other small supermarket type goods from this charitable organisation. Last year we received over 200 banana boxes of frozen meals – that's a considerable amount!

I have appreciated the efficient and reliable service KCA provides. Orders are promptly processed and there is excellent communication around the delivery and pick-up of our order. This is important as we travel a reasonable distance from Lower Hutt to Tawa to do this.

In 2019 we provided 1,542 food parcels for 3,818 people in the Lower Hutt area from Stokes Valley to Petone, including Wainuiomata. Each of those parcels would have contained multiple goods from KCA. We provide the basic items and tinned foods but the food we receive through KCA enables us to give people meat or a complete meat or fish based meal, both of which are significant items for people and much appreciated.
