Located in Linden, He Huarahi Tamariki is a purpose built complex which includes Kids Count, an Early Childhood Centre, catering for the children of our students.

We are very fortunate to work with a number of agencies, including KCA. We have been gratefully receiving donations since July 2014. These donations come in many forms, from clothing and winter blankets to weekly deliveries of milk, bread, produce and much more.
